Ryan is a junior barrister with a developing practice in construction, commercial and property disputes. The core focus of Ryan's practice is construction and engineering disputes. Ryan has been instructed in several disputes arising out of national and international infrastructure projects as well as residential renovation and disrepair claims. He has recently acted as junior counsel in an ICC arbitration concerning a large infrastructure project in the Middle East with an overall value in dispute of at least \$500 million. Ryan is familiar with a broad range of standard form and bespoke contracts used across the spectrum of construction projects, including the JCT, NEC and FIDIC forms. He also has significant experience in claims brought by or against the National House Building Council, the market-leading insurer and warranty provider for new-build and refurbished properties in the UK. He is regularly instructed to advise in respect of adjudications, including providing early stage advice in respect of payment notices and "smash and grab" disputes.

Ryan is also a keen follower of academic developments in construction law. In 2018 he received 2nd prize in the annual Hudson Essay Competition run by the Society of Construction Law for his paper titled 'Hanging by a slender thread: Design obligations in construction contracts following MT Højgaard v E.ON'.
