In accordance with the BSB Handbook, participation in the survey is voluntary. Individuals may choose not to take part or may opt out of having their responses included in the published data.

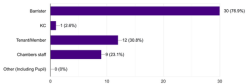
All information presented in this report has been anonymised.

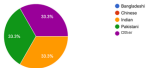
